



# Covid-19 Guidelines & Protocols

---

Please note that these protocols are in accordance with the latest guidelines from Public Health. As new updates to the guidelines become available, we will update our guidelines and protocols to match the up to date recommendations of Public Health Guidelines.

## Physical Distancing

- Children will be placed in groups of a maximum of 10 people including the caring counselor that will spend the week with them.
- Each group will be assigned their own physical space which will act as a bubble. Members of other groups will not be permitted to enter that “bubble”.
- If another staff member must enter the “bubble” to interact with the group they will wear a mask at all times, they will also maintain physical distancing if possible

## Mask protocols

- As per current Public Health Guidelines, Children who have completed grade 1 or higher, must wear a mask while indoor at the campus facility. Children completing SK and JK are recommended to wear a mask as well while indoors.
- Camp Tournesol Staff will wear a mask at all times indoors and outdoors when not physically distanced.
- Staff who greet children and who interact with children from more than one “bubble” will wear a face shield as well as a mask.

## Drop off and pick up

- Parent’s will not be allowed inside the building where camp is held.
- Parent’s will be assigned a time slot to pick up and drop off their child, this is to ensure there is no contact from children in separate “bubbles.”
- Children will be screened either via temperature check or questionnaire before entering the building.

## Hand washing and sanitizing

- Hand washing will be emphasized before and after snack and lunch and before and after the use of the washroom
- Hand Sanitizer will be available in every room
- Staff will use an EPA approved disinfectant, before and after use of any surface such as tables, desks, etc..
- Staff will use an EPA approved disinfectant, before and after use of any materials and equipment such as balls, pencils, etc...



# Covid-19 Guidelines & Protocols

## To limit spread of germs

- Kids will be instructed to not touch their faces, if they do so we will sanitize or wash their hands
- We will restrict games where campers are required to touch other campers such as tag
- No food will be shared between campers.

## Maintaining a safe environment at camp

- Children are asked to not come to camp if they had a fever in the last 48 hours
- If a child seems sluggish or is complaining that he does not feel well, we will take his temperature
- If a child has a temperature higher than 98.9°F or 37.9°C, they will be sent home and asked not to return until 48 hours after they record a temperature of under 38.0°C or 99.0°F
- Staff will carefully monitor campers who display other symptoms such as coughing and shortage of breath. Notify parents if these symptoms persist for more than 20 minutes
- Any child displaying symptoms will be removed from their group and isolated until they are picked up by their parents
